Having exercised our option to earn an 80% interest from SOQUEM five years ahead of schedule, we are now moving at an accelerated pace toward a Preliminary Economic Assessment (PEA).

The Role – Field Project Geologist

Key Responsibilities

- **Drill Program Execution:** Manage the daily operations of diamond drill rigs to ensure targets are met safely and efficiently
- **Rig Supervision:** participate in drill line-ups, shutdowns, and rig moves; spot drill holes and verify azimuth/inclination.
- **Contractor Accountability:** Track daily drilling progress, review and sign off on daily shift reports (plod sheets), and monitor consumables/meterage for invoice verification.
- **Technical Guidance:** Provide real-time geological guidance to drillers to optimize core recovery and handle difficult ground conditions.
- **Downhole/Directional Surveys:** Oversee or perform downhole or directional orientation surveys and contractors.



- Site Services Contractor Management: Supervise site services contractors in the maintenance of access roads, drill pads preparation and drill move logistics.
- Inspections: Perform regular safety audits and workplace inspections of drill rigs and support equipment to ensure compliance with company and regulatory standards.
- Incident Management: Lead the reporting and investigation of any "Near Misses" or incidents; implement immediate corrective actions.
- Environmental Stewardship: Ensure all contractors adhere to environmental permits (e.g., fluid containment, waste management, and site reclamation).
- Emergency Response: Act as the on-site safety lead, maintaining first aid supplies and emergency communication protocols.
- Logging & Sampling: Perform detailed lithological, structural, and geotechnical logging of drill core.
- QA/QC Management: Implement and monitor Quality Assurance/Quality Control programs, including the insertion of standards, blanks, and duplicates.

Required Qualifications

- Experience: 5+ years in geosciences within the Canadian mining sector (Quebec experience is highly preferred).
- Education: B.Sc. in Geology of Geological Engineering
- Extended knowledge of REAFIE and RADF regulations
- Professional Designation: OGQ or equivalent is essential
- Language: French language is essential, bilingualism (English/French) is a strong asset.
