


## **Job Posting:** Core Shack Supervisor Technician

Reporting to the Project Geologist, this permanent, full-time position offers a unique opportunity to make a tangible contribution to the development of a leading polymetallic project in the Abitibi Greenstone Belt.

### Main Responsibilities:

- Supervise and coordinate all core shack activities according to the priorities established by the project geologist.
- Supervise core shack technicians and general labourers.
- Perform core measurements and take RQD measurements.
- Identify and correct block and box measurement errors upon core receipt.
- Train new technicians in continuous measurement.
- Perform and maintain an inventory of cores on pallets and in racks.
- Perform and maintain an up-to-date inventory of pulp and rejects received from the laboratory.
- Ensure the proper maintenance of the yard and buildings.
- Search for pulp and rejects upon request for reanalysis.
- Prepare drill core shipments to the saw room.
- Receive orders and manage consumables and supplies inventory.
- Provide logistical support to geologists.
- Suggest improvements and optimizations to various practices.
- Ensure compliance with health and safety requirements and company policies.
- Assist geologists with other related tasks relevant to the progress and success of the project.
